## Practice analytics – Using health data to support clinical change

Professor Tim Shaw will describe a practice analytic program across five private hospitals in Australia and the Colleges of Surgeons and Physicians. This program looks at how teams make sense of health data and how this can be used in clinical settings to support reflection and practice change as well as link to professional development requirements.

Tim is the Professor of Digital Health and Director of the Research in Implementation Science and eHealth Group (RISe) in the Faculty of Medicine and Health at the University of Sydney. Tim has led an active research and development team at the University of Sydney since 2000 that has focused on implementation science. His current focus is on how we use health data to impact on clinical decision making, quality improvement and professional development.

Ivana Goluzza Riddell will be chairing the session. Ivana is the Lead, Strategy and Engagement at the Bureau of Health Information (BHI). BHI is a board governed organisation that publishes independent reports about the performance of the NSW healthcare system.
