1. Why am I using RIVAROXABAN-TEVA?

RIVAROXABAN-TEVA contains the active ingredient

Rivaroxaban. RIVAROXABAN-TEVA is an anticoagulant. It works by inhibiting the blood clotting protein called Factor Xa, thus reducing the tendency of blood to form clots.

RIVAROXABAN-TEVA 10, 15 and 20 mg tablets are used to:

- Prevent blood clots in your veins after a hip or knee

replacement operation because after an operation you are at an increased risk of getting blood clots

- Prevent blood clots in your brain (stroke) and/or other blood vessels in your body if you have a form of irregular heart rhythm called non-valvular atrial fibrillation
- Treat blood clots in the veins of your legs (deep vein thrombosis, DVT) and clots in your lung (pulmonary embolism, PE) and to prevent blood clots from reoccurring in your legs and/or lungs.

RIVAROXABAN-TEVA 2.5 mg tablets twice daily along with aspirin 100 mg once daily, is used to:

- prevent major heart related events (stroke, heart attack and death from heart related conditions) if you have poor blood flow in the blood vessels of your heart (coronary artery disease or CAD) and/or arms and legs (peripheral artery disease or PAD).

- You are allergic to rivaroxaban, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
