1. Why am I using VANCOMYCIN BAXTER?

VANCOMYCIN BAXTER contains the

hydrochloride. Vancomycin is an antibiotic which helps your body fight serious or severe infections by eliminating certain bacteria that cause infections.

- Severe staphylococcal infections
- Endocarditis, an infection that causes inflammation of the lining of the heart
- Osteomyelitis (bone infection)
- Pneumonia (lung infection)
- Septicaemia (infection of the blood)
- Infection of the skin
- Infections in the intestines
