1. Why am I taking Sitaglo?

Sitaglo contains the active ingredient sitagliptin.

Sitaglo is a member of a class of medicines you take by mouth called DPP-4 inhibitors (dipeptidyl peptidase-4 inhibitors) that lowers blood sugar levels in adults with type 2 diabetes mellitus.

Sitaglo is used to lower blood sugar levels in adults with type 2 diabetes mellitus.

Sitaglo can be used alone or in combination with certain other medicines that lower blood sugar along with a recommended diet and exercise program.
