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1. Why am I using NOUMED CELECOXIB?

NOUMED CELECOXIB contains the active ingredient celecoxib. NOUMED CELECOXIB belongs to a group of medicines called Coxibs which are used to relieve pain and inflammation in a number of conditions.

Although NOUMED CELECOXIB can relieve the symptoms of pain and inflammation, it will not cure your condition. Your doctor, however, may have prescribed NOUMED CELECOXIB for another purpose.

NOUMED CELECOXIB is used to relieve the symptoms of joint pain, tenderness, swelling and stiffness in osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis and ankylosing spondylitis, a chronic inflammatory rheumatic disorder that primarily affects, but is not limited to, the spine.

NOUMED CELECOXIB also provides short-term pain relief in conditions such as menstrual cramps or period pain, after surgery, muscle and joint injuries.

2. What should I know before I use NOUMED CELECOXIB?

Warnings

Do not use NOUMED CELECOXIB if:

- you are allergic to celecoxib, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet. Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.
- your doctor has told you that you have severe heart or blood vessel disease affecting the circulation in your brain or limbs.
- you have severe liver problems. Your doctor will decide if your condition is too severe to take this medicine.
