1. Why am I using HYDROCORTISONE JUNO?

HYDROCORTISONE JUNO contains the active ingredient hydrocortisone sodium succinate. HYDROCORTISONE JUNO is a corticosteroid and is used to reduce inflammation (pain, swelling, redness and heat).
