1. Why am I taking MOXONIDINE-WGR?

MOXONIDINE-WGR contains the active ingredient moxonidine. MOXONIDINE-WGR is used to lower high blood pressure, which is sometimes called hypertension.

Everyone has blood pressure. This pressure helps to move blood around your body. Your blood pressure may change at different times of the day. You have hypertension when your blood pressure stays higher than normal, even when you are calm or relaxed.

There are usually no symptoms of hypertension. The only way of knowing if you have hypertension is
