1. Why am I using ONDANSETRON-WGR?

ONDANSETRON-WGR contains the active ingredient ondansetron (as hydrochloride dihydrate). ONDANSETRON-WGR belongs to a group of medicines called serotonin receptor-3 antagonists.

ONDANSETRON WGR is used to help stop the nausea (sick feeling) and vomiting which can occur after medical treatments and operations.

ONDANSETRON-WGR should only be used to treat the nausea and vomiting for which they have been prescribed.
