1. Why am I using Fosaprepitant-AFT?

Fosaprepitant-AFT contains the active ingredient Fosaprepitant dimeglumine. Fosaprepitant-AFT is an antiemetic drug for prevention of chemotherapy induced nausea and vomiting.

Fosaprepitant-AFT in combination with other medicines, is used to prevent nausea (feeling sick) and vomiting associated with cancer chemotherapy.

Fosaprepitant-AFT belongs to a group of medicines called neurokinin 1 (NK1) receptor antagonists. It works by blocking
