Relpax® Migraine contains the active ingredient eletriptan hydrobromide.

Relpax® Migraine is a serotonin agonist, that works by reducing the size of swollen blood vessels around the brain that may be involved in migraine.

Relpax® Migraine is used to treat a migraine attack.

Relpax® Migraine tablets do not work in other types of headache, which are not migraine.
