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## 1. Why am I taking Isturisa?

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**Isturisa contains the active ingredient osilodrostat.**

**Isturisa is used in adults to treat endogenous Cushing's syndrome.**

Cushing's syndrome is a condition in which the body produces too much of a hormone called cortisol. Too much cortisol may lead to a variety of symptoms such as weight gain (particularly around the waist), a moon-shaped face, bruising easily, irregular periods, excessive body and facial hair, and generally feeling weak, tired or unwell.

**Isturisa blocks the main enzyme that makes cortisol in the adrenal glands.** The effect of this is to decrease the over-production of cortisol and improve the symptoms
