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1. Why am I using SALFLUMIX EASYHALER?

SALFLUMIX EASYHALER contains two active ingredients, fluticasone propionate and salmeterol.

- Fluticasone propionate is a corticosteroid which reduces swelling and irritation in the lungs.
- Salmeterol is a long-acting bronchodilator. Bronchodilators help the airways in the lungs to stay open. This makes it easier

for air to get in and out. The effects last for up to 12 hours.

SALFLUMIX EASYHALER is used to help prevent breathing problems such as:

- Asthma
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)

SALFLUMIX EASYHALER helps to **prevent** breathlessness and wheeziness in people who need regular treatment.

DO NOT use this medicine to treat a sudden attack of breathlessness as it will not help you. If that happens you need to use a fast acting 'reliever' medication, such as salbutamol.

Do not use SALFLUMIX EASYHALER if:

- you are allergic to fluticasone propionate, salmeterol xinafoate, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.
