1. Why am I using Tayneos?

Tavneos contains the active ingredient avacopan. Avacopan binds to a specific inflammation causing proteinin the body, called complement 5a receptor and blocks itsinflammatory effects.

This prevents the inflammatoryeffects of white blood cells called neutrophils. Tavneos is used in combination with other medicines forthe treatment of adults with anti-neutrophil cytoplasmicautoantibody (ANCA)-associated vasculitis (diseasescaused by inflammation of the small blood vessels), thetypes of ANCA vasculitis are known as GPA and MPA.

 you are allergic to avacopan, or any of theingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
