1. What is CARBOPROST DR.REDDY'S used for?

CARBOPROST DR.REDDY'S contains the active ingredient carboprost trometamol.

Carboprost trometamol belongs to a group of medicines called prostaglandins. Prostaglandins are produced naturally in your body and are very important for a variety of activities, including childbirth. After childbirth they make the womb contract and to help it stay contracted, which stops heavy bleeding from the womb.

CARBOPROST DR.REDDY'S given after childbirth increases the contraction of your womb which helps to control bleeding after delivery.

2. What should I know before I use CARBOPROST DR.REDDY'S?

Warnings

Do not use CARBOPROST DR.REDDY'S if:

 you are allergic to carboprost trometamol, or any of the ingredients listed in section 6, in particular benzyl alcohol which can cause problems in some people. See Section 4 of this leaflet for more details.

Symptoms of an allergic reaction may include:

- shortness of breath, wheezing or difficulty breathing
- swelling of the face, lips, tongue or other parts of the body, skin rash, itching or hives.
