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1. Why am I using Nurtec ODT?

Nurtec ODT contains the active ingredient rimegepant, that stops the activity of a substance in the body called calcitonin gene-related peptide (CGRP). People with migraine may have increased levels of CGRP. Nurtec ODT works by reducing the activity of CGRP in the body and as a result:

1. it can stop an active migraine attack
2. it can decrease the number of migraine attacks that occur when taken prophylactically.

Nurtec ODT is used to treat and prevent migraine attacks, with or without aura, in adults.

2. What should I know before I use Nurtec ODT?

Warnings

Do not use Nurtec ODT if:

- you are allergic to rimegepant, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet. Symptoms of an allergic reaction may include:
 - shortness of breath
 - wheezing or difficulty breathing
 - swelling of the face, lips, tongue or other parts of the body
 - rash, itching or hives on the skin.

Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.

Check with your doctor if you:

have or have had any other medical conditions, especially the following:

- severe liver problems
- reduced kidney function or are on kidney dialysis.
- take any medicines for any other condition
