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## 1. Why am I taking Solifenacin Dr.Reddy's?

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**Solifenacin Dr.Reddy's contains the active ingredient solifenacin succinate.** Solifenacin Dr.Reddy's belongs to a group of medicines called anticholinergic medicines. It works by acting on specialised cells to reduce the activity of your bladder and help you control your bladder.

Solifenacin Dr.Reddy's is used to treat the symptoms of overactive bladder.
