1. Why am I using ROXITHROMYCIN-WGR?

ROXITHROMYCIN-WGR contains the active ingredient roxithromycin.

ROXITHROMYCIN-WGR is an antibiotic that belongs to a group of medicines called macrolides. These antibiotics work by killing or stopping the growth of the bacteria that are causing your infection.

ROXITHROMYCIN-WGR, like other antibiotics, does not work against viral infections such as the flu.

ROXITHROMYCIN-WGR is used to treat infections in different parts of the body caused by bacteria. For example:

- acute pharyngitis (sore throat and discomfort when swallowing)
- tonsillitis
- sinusitis
- acute bronchitis (infection of the bronchi causing coughing)
- exacerbation of chronic bronchitis
- pneumonia (lung infection characterised by fever, malaise, headache)
- · skin and soft tissue infections
- non gonococcal urethritis
- impetigo (bacterial infection causing sores on the skin).
