1. Why am I using Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin?

Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin contains the active ingredient cefalexin monohydrate.

Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin is an antibiotic used to treat infections in different parts of the body caused by bacteria.

Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin belongs to a group of antibiotics called cephalosporins. These antibiotics work by killing the bacteria that are causing your infection. Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin can be used to treat infections of the:

- respiratory tract (throat, tonsils, chest, and lungs)
- nose (sinusitis)
- ears (otitis media)
- skin and soft tissue
- kidneys and bladder (genitourinary tract).

Your doctor may have prescribed Blooms The Chemist Cefalexin for another reason.
