- 1. Why am I using Blooms The Chemist Amoxicillin/Clavulanic Acid 875/125 tablets?

Blooms The Chemist Amoxicillin/Clavulanic Acid 875/125 tablets contains two active ingredients. One of these is a penicillin called amoxicillin and the other is clavulanic acid.

Blooms The Chemist Amoxicillin/Clavulanic Acid 875/125 tablets belong to the penicillin group of antibiotics. Blooms The Chemist Amoxicillin/Clavulanic Acid 875/125 tablets works by killing the bacteria that cause these infections. It will not work against infections caused by viruses such as colds or the flu.

Blooms The Chemist Amoxicillin/Clavulanic Acid 875/125 tablets are used for the short term treatment of a wide range of infections in the body caused by bacteria. These infections may affect the chest (bronchitis or pneumonia), bladder (cystitis), sinuses (sinusitis), the ears (otitis media) or the
