1. Why am I using LURASIDONE SUN?

LURASIDONE SUN contains the active ingredient lurasidone hydrochloride. LURASIDONE

SUN is an atypical antipsychotic. It helps to correct chemical imbalances in the brain, which may cause mental illness.

LURASIDONE SUN is used to treat adults and adolescents (aged 13 years or over) with schizophrenia. Schizophrenia is a mental illness with disturbances in thinking, feelings and behaviour.

Your doctor may have prescribed LURASIDONE SUN for another

reason. Ask your doctor if you have any questions about why LURASIDONE SUN has been prescribed for you.

2. What should I know before I use LURASIDONE SUN?

Warnings

Do not use LURASIDONE SUN if:

- you are allergic to lurasidone hydrochloride, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.
- you are taking medicines that can affect how your body processes LURASIDONE SUN such as:
 - ketoconazole or voriconazole, used to treat certain fungal infections
