1. Why am I using GENTAMICIN NORIDEM?

GENTAMICIN NORIDEM contains the active ingredient Gentamicin sulfate.

GENTAMICIN NORIDEM is an antibiotic that belongs to a group of medicines called aminoglycosides (pronounced a-my-noe-GLY-koesides).

GENTAMICIN NORIDEM is used to treat serious bacterial infections. Gentamicin works by killing bacteria or preventing their growth. It is used for the treatment of serious infections, including:
