1. Why am I being given AMPHOTERICIN LIPOSOMAL SUN?

AMPHOTERICIN LIPOSOMAL

SUN contains the active ingredient liposomal amphotericin B (amphotericin). AMPHOTERICIN LIPOSOMAL SUN belongs to a group of medicines called antifungals.

AMPHOTERICIN LIPOSOMAL SUN is used to help the body overcome serious fungal infections by either killing the fungus or stopping it spreading. Amphotericin B (amphotericin) is also used to treat a disease which is rare in Australia called leishmaniasis.

- you are allergic to amphotericin
 B (amphotericin), or any of the

- have, or have had, any of the following medical conditions:
