1. Why am I using EIKANCE 0.01%?

EIKANCE 0.01% contains the active ingredient atropine sulfate monohydrate (atropine). EIKANCE 0.01% is an eye drop preparation used to deliver atropine directly to the eye for local activity. It reduces the rate of unwanted changes in the eye which may slow the progression of near sightedness (myopia).

EIKANCE 0.01% Eye Drops are used as a treatment to slow the progression of myopia in children aged from 4 to 14 years.

2. What should I know before I use EIKANCE 0.01%?

Warnings

Do not use EIKANCE 0.01% if:

- you are allergic to atropine, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.
- if you have angle closure glaucoma or a family history of glaucoma.
- the expiry date printed on the pack has passed. If you use it after the expiry date has passed, it may have no effect at all, or worse, there may be an entirely unexpected effect.
- if the packaging is torn or shows signs of tampering.
