1. Why am I using VANCOMYCIN JUNO?

VANCOMYCIN JUNO contains the active ingredient vancomycin hydrochloride. Vancomycin is an antibiotic. It works by killing the bacteria causing the infection

VANCOMYCIN JUNO is used:

- to treat serious infections caused by bacteria (germs).
 These infections may occur in different parts of the body.
- orally, to treat serious infections involving the bowel.

2. What should I know before I use VANCOMYCIN JUNO?

Warnings

Do not use VANCOMYCIN JUNO if:

you are allergic to vancomycin.

Check with your doctor if you:

- you are allergic to any other medicines (such as teicoplanin, a drug used to treat infections), or any foods, dyes or preservatives
- have any other medical conditions, in particular kidney or liver disease, or if you have suffered from hearing loss
- take any medicines for any other condition.

During treatment, you may be at risk of developing certain side effects. It is important you understand these risks and how to monitor for them. See additional information under Section 6. Are there any side effects?
